## DS - The Pragmatic Leader THE FOURTEEN ARCHETYPES

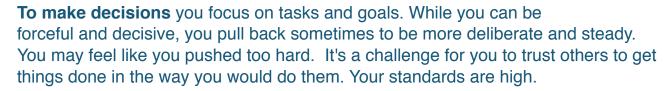
You are a D -S. Your management style is the Pragmatic Leader.
